Definitions

- **Credit:** .5 earned per class, per semester when grade equals 60% or higher. For year long classes, students must pass BOTH semesters to receive the full 1 year credit for the course.
- **Graduation Requirement:** class you have to pass in order to graduate.
- **Prerequisite:** a course and/or grade that is required before taking another course.
