
Today was our first binder check of the year! During our Homeroom time, teachers reviewed each student’s binder to check for organization and neatness. Specific criteria were reviewed within two categories, and students received a “Met” or “Not Met” evaluation for each category. Below, please find the criteria outlined within each category. A student must meet each criteria in the category to have received a “Met.”

Organization:

- Team Cover
- Pencil Pouch with Appropriate Supplies
- Agenda
- Dividers
- Small Stack of Notebook Paper
- Homework Folder

Neatness:

- Papers are neatly organized. (All papers are hole punched and located behind correct tab OR located in correct folders.)



The form includes the following elements:

- Logos for ISD and My AVID.
- Fields for Student's Name and Date.
- Title: AVID Binder Quick Check
- Table with columns: Category, Criteria Checklist, Met, Not Met.
- Section for Goal/Reflection.
