going ice skating?)

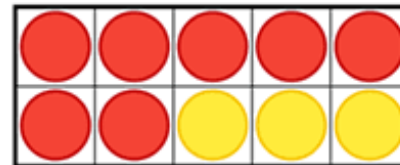
### NUMBER DETECTIVES
