Read the following linked story:

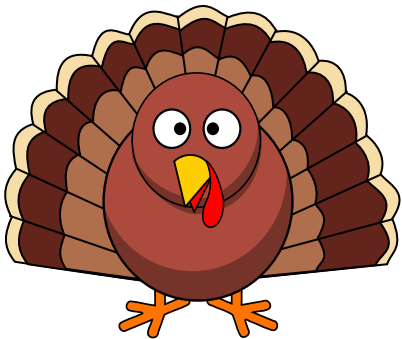

### PROBLEM SOLVING

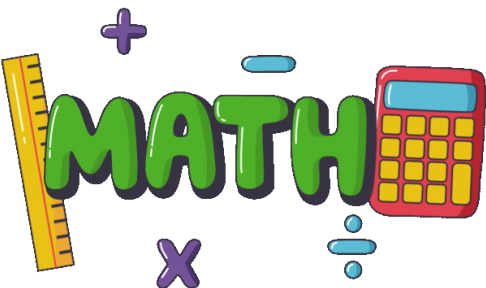
Create a word problem that include real life scenarios and use your child's name. (ie-Tony has 3 bugs and gave 2 to Steph. How many bugs does she have left?)
