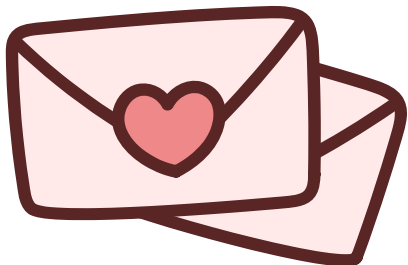

- 5 in the ones place



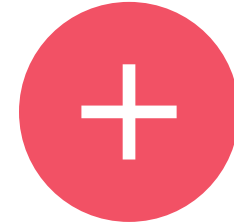
## MATH GAMES

## NUMBER DETECTIVES

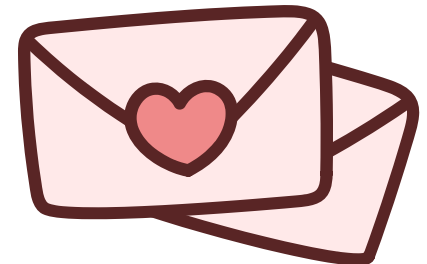
Practice counting backwards from 0-20.
