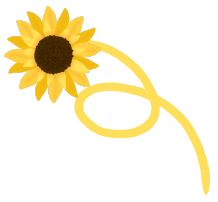

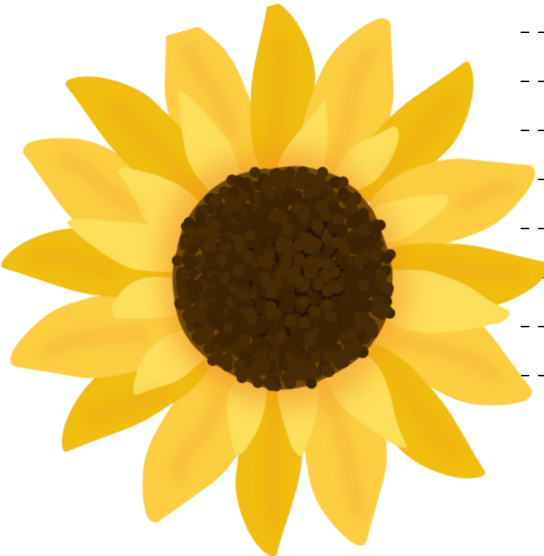

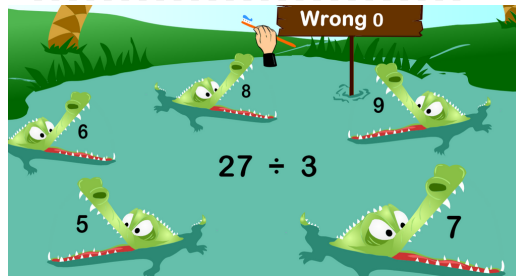

I am between 45 and 54. The sum of my digits is 6. What number am I?

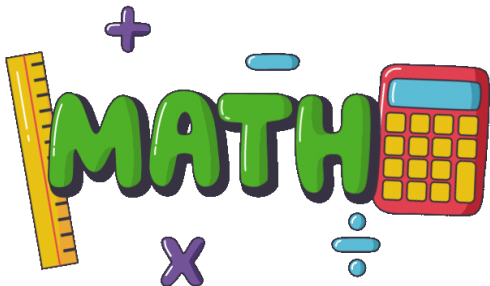
I am less than 30. I am greater than the number of cents in a quarter. I have 9 ones. What number am I?
