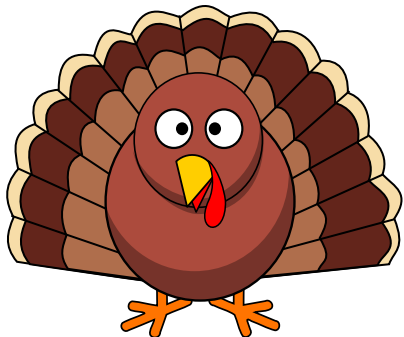

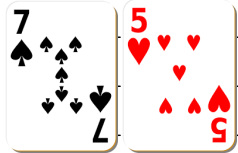

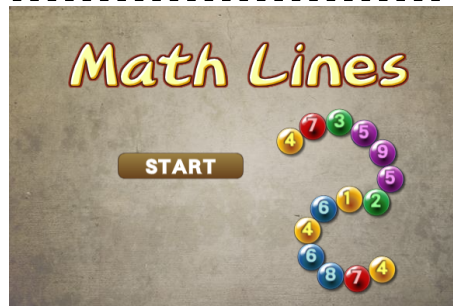
PLACE VALUE
