Learning Target:

Students will learn to take turns during play.

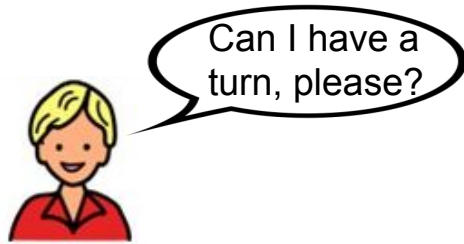
My name is Jon. I like to play with my brother. When we play, we take turns so that we can all play happily together.

Let's learn about taking turns!



Here are some things to remember about taking turns:

1) When I want a toy that my brother or sister is playing, I can say “ can I have a turn, please?” or “my turn, please?”



2) I wait until my brother or sister is done with his or her turn.



Here are some things to remember about taking turns:

3) It is ok to wait. While I wait, I can find another toy to play with or find a grown-up.



4) When my brother or sister is done, it is my turn



Here are some things to remember about taking turns:

5) When my turn is up, I can share my toy with my brother or sister.



6) I can wait for my next turn or find a new toy to play with.



Here are some things to remember about taking turns:

7) Sometimes, my brother or sister says “no”. I can be OK and find another toy to play with.



I can play with what my brother or sister is playing later.



Self-Check:

Let's practice taking turns by playing a game with a grown-up or your brother or sister.



Some games that you can play are:

1) **Building a tower**

- Every person will have some blocks and will take turns to build a tower by adding one block to the tower at a time.



2) **Connect the train**

- Every person has some connecting pieces of the train, and will take turns adding pieces of the train together.



3) **Simple board games** (e.g., Candyland)

4) **Simple card games** (e.g., Go Fish)
