You count to 5.



If I say: "Count to 5."
You don't count to 5.

Ready?



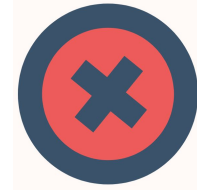
“Simon says” caregiver notes:

Wait for eye contact or calm body to give a direction.

Give one direction at a time.

Take a turn being the one to practice listening and doing what Simon says.

Use these or your own ideas!



Raise your arms.
Touch your toes.
Wiggle your nose.
Touch your knees.
Make a funny face.
Stand on one foot.
Yawn.
Start singing.
Count to 10.
Clap your hands.

Sit down.
Climb a pretend ladder.
Cover your eyes.
Do a silly dance.
Freeze.
Give yourself a hug.
Laugh.
Make an animal noise.
Stomp your feet.
Smile.
