Students will identify different types of bugs

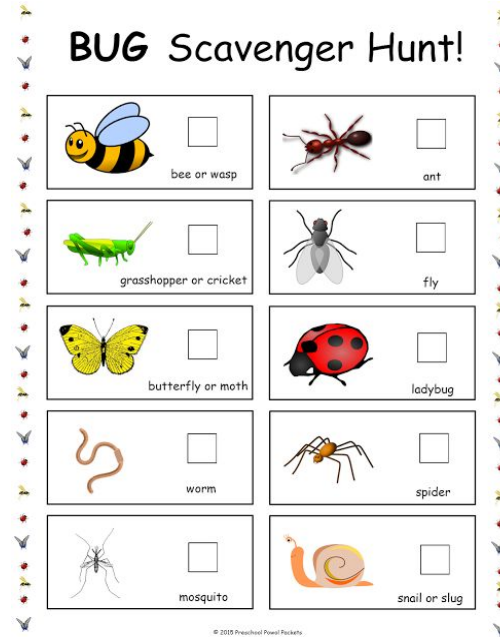
Let's Get Started:

Talk about the different characteristics:

- Can it fly?
- Amount of legs?
- What do they eat?
- Where do they live?
- Does it bite or sting?



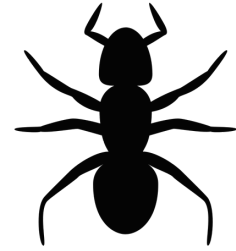
During reading questions: Play “SPOT” the bug throughout each page. Talk about about how helpful each bug is to our environment.

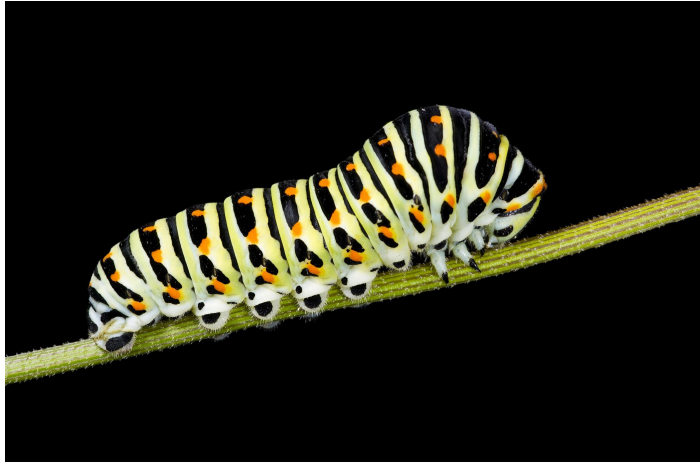


Where does an Ant live?

How many legs does a ladybug have?

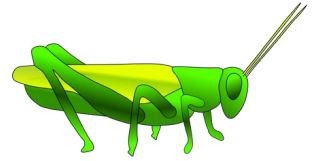
