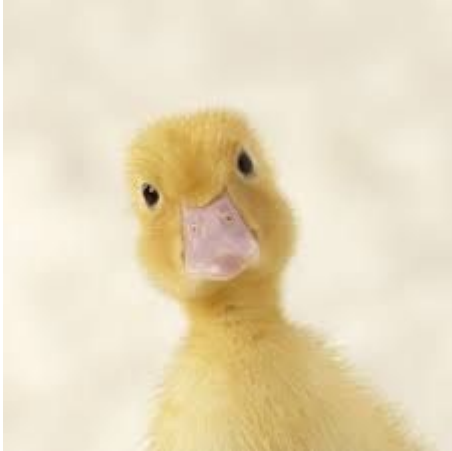
Learning Target:
