Practice:

What do you do when you want to cross the street?



You look both directions (left and right) before crossing the street. You hold an adult's hand.

Practice:

What do you do when you see a house on fire?



You tell an adult and call 9-1-1 (fire department).

Practice:

What do you do when you want to go outside and it is raining?



You get a raincoat, rain boots, and umbrella.

Activity:

-Practice dialing a phone number or calling 911.

Materials: Paper and Markers

Create 13 squares and write the numbers (0-9, #, *) plus a picture of a phone.
