Learning Target:


Students will develop an awareness of the sights and colors of Spring as they observe and record.

Let's Get Started: Color Me Spring

Practice:

Go around your house and create a tally chart with different items.

- Shirts, cars, block/ Legos, socks



Directions for Activity:

- 1. Talk with your child about spring. What new colors do we see?
- 2. Take a walk with your child. Each time they see a color, make a mark in the that column.
- 3. When you return home, your child will have a record of the colors of spring that they observed.
- 4. Count how many things of each color that you saw. Compare which colors you saw the most and the least.

Activity:

Materials: crayons, ruler, paper

Directions: Help your child make a color tally board on paper using the crayons to draw the lines.
