Look and say this pattern(tulip,daisy).







Look and say this pattern(rose, daisy).







Look and say this pattern(rose,dandelion).








Activity:

-Find items with the same pattern:

1. Find patterns around the house:

fabrics, wallpaper, tiles, carpet.



2. Find patterns outside: flowers, leaves, fruit/vegetables.

-Create your own pattern: Use objects to help your child make patterns such as blocks, legos, beads, buttons, or crackers.

While creating your pattern, ask your child what comes next.
