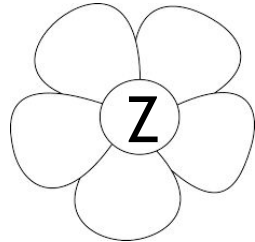
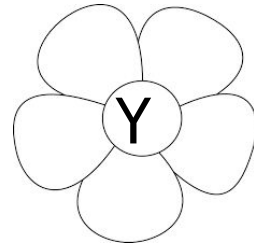
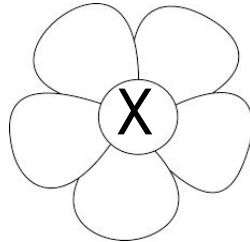
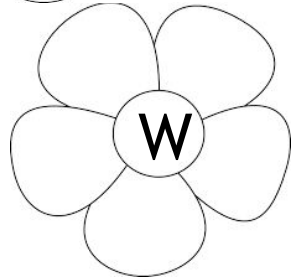
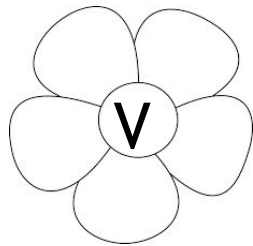
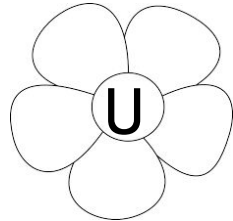
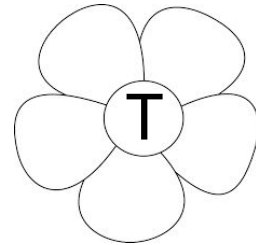
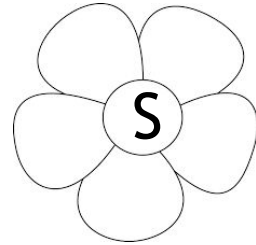
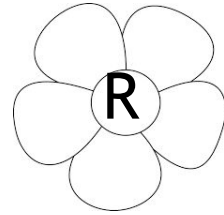
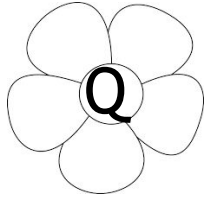
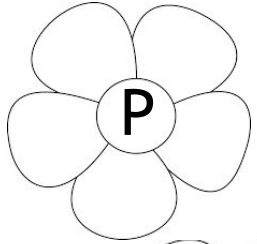
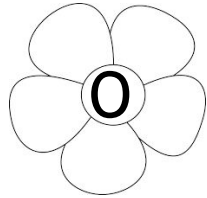
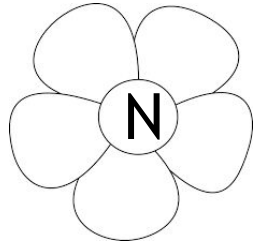
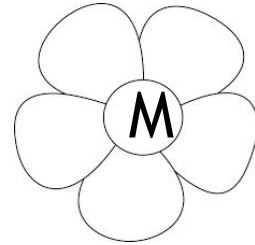
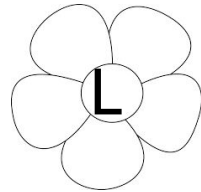
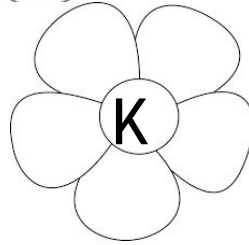
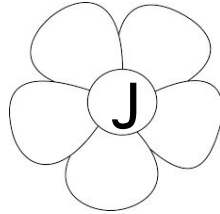
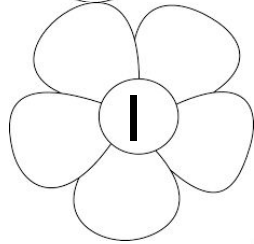
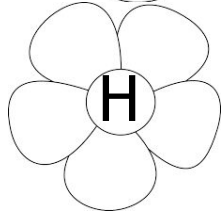
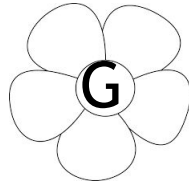
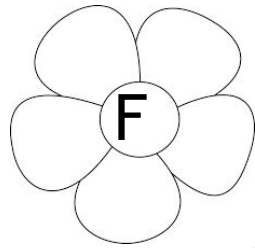
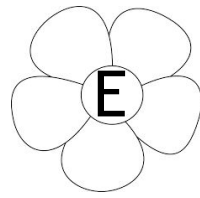
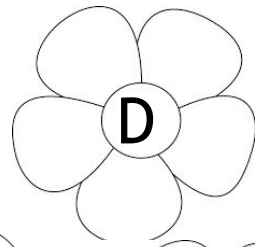
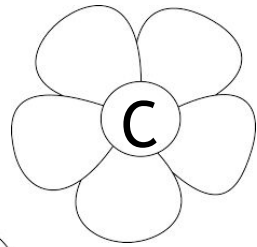
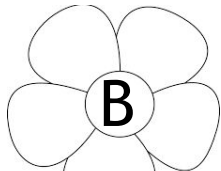
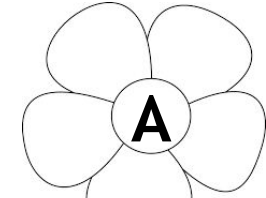
Create a Sensory Bin - Use items to create a letter garden.
