# **Background:** This is a worksheet to practice production of the /p/ sound.


- Students will review therapist productions /p/ in isolation, initial position, and final position.



## If you picked lips, you are right!


- Remember, no tongue or teeth showing.

- You should be able to make a tissue move.






#### Time to practice!


We can have pancakes for breakfast. Yum!



Practice your /p/ sound using the pancakes! Feel free to cut them out and make your own pancake breakfast!









