Learning Target:


Students will use one-to-one correspondence to count the flower petals.





Activity:

Thumbprint Flowers

-Materials needed: paint, markers, paper or poster board.



- 1. Put a small amount of paint on a plate. Help your child put a little paint on his thumb and press thumb on paper.
- 2. Repeat in a circular pattern to make a daisy.
- 3. Use markers to draw a stem and leaves.
