
Learning Target:


Students will learn about the different colors of healthy foods.

Let's Get Started:


Read Aloud: Planting A Rainbow

What vegetable is orange that rabbits like to eat?






What vegetable is green that makes a good salad?







What fruit is red and grows on trees?

Activity:

Planting a Rainbow Garden

-Materials - magazine pictures of gardens, paper chart, crayons or markers, glue
