Early Childhood Special Education Reading Lesson: May 2020

Learning Target:

Students will learn how to move like a plant.

Let's Get Started:

Read Aloud: Plants Can't Sit Still By:Rebecca E. Hircsh

First, a seedling will move when it starts to grow.



Can you **<u>SQUIRM</u>** like the seed?

Next, a plant will move out into the soil.



Can you <u>Wiggle</u> like the plant?

Then, a plant will move to get to the warmth and the light.



Can you **<u>REACH</u>** for the sunlight?

Last, some plants have flowers that clothes up and sleep at night.



Can you <u>Nod</u> at the moon?

Activity:

Action Songs for kids - The Singing Walrus

Extension - Create your own action cards

Examples:

- Slither like a snake
- Crawl through the grass
- Wiggle like a worm
- Hop like a grasshopper
- March like an ant
