ECSE Pronouns Lesson: May 2020

Learning Target:

Students will produce sentences containing "I" and "me" pronouns.

Background: This is a lesson to teach when to use "I" and "me" pronouns correctly.

- Students will review when to use either "I" or "me."
- Students will practice saying sentences containing each pronoun.

And you can say "me" if you are getting!




Good remembering!


Now let's do lots of practice! We will make our own sentences using pictures.
