




#### What does a worm do?

Read a book




#### Dig in the soil

## <u>Activity:</u>



Items needed:

- -tub/bucket
- -sand or dirt
- -drinking straws

Fill a tub with sand or dirt. Cut drinking straws into different lengths. Hide them in the sand. Encourage children to pretend to play with the family of worms.



While playing, ask your child the following questions:

- 1. Where do worms live?
- 2. What do worms do?
- 3. Why are worms important?
