Learning Target:

Students will learn how to be a better listener.

Let's Get Started: Listening is good Yes or No?

Practice: Who is using their eyes to look?



Practice:
Who is using their ears to listen?



Practice:

4 steps to LISTENING - Ask your child to practice listening with you.

1. **STOP** what you are doing.



2. **LOOK** at the speaker.



3. **HEAR** what they are saying.



4. **THINK** about what they said.



Activity:

Use 4 paper plates to play, Simon Says with your child.

On plate 1 - Draw a stop sign on it that says STOP

On plate 2 - Draw two big eyes on it that says LOOK

On plate 3 - Draw ears that say HEAR

On plate 4 - Draw a head that says THINK

-Simon says touch your nose. Simon says touch your ears.

-Touch your chin (show ear plate for listening-Simon didn't say!)

-Simon says clap your hands.**STOP** (use ear plate for listening-Simon didn't say!)
