Learning Target:

Students will learn how to be a better listener.

Let's Get Started: Listening is good Yes or No?

Practice: Who is using their eyes to look?





Practice: Who is using their ears to listen?





Practice:

4 steps to LISTENING - Ask your child to practice listening with you.

1. STOP what you are doing. STOP



- 2. LOOK at the speaker.
- 3. **HEAR** what they are saying.







Activity:

Use 4 paper plates to play, Simon Says with your child.

- On plate 1 Draw a stop sign on it that says <u>STOP</u>
- On plate 2 Draw two big eyes on it that says <u>LOOK</u>
- On plate 3 Draw ears that say <u>HEAR</u>
- On plate 4 Draw a head that says <u>THINK</u>
- -Simon says touch your nose. Simon says touch your ears.
- -Touch your chin (show ear plate for listening-Simon didn't say!)
- -Simon says clap your hands.STOP (use ear plate for listening-Simon didn't say!)
