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Activity:

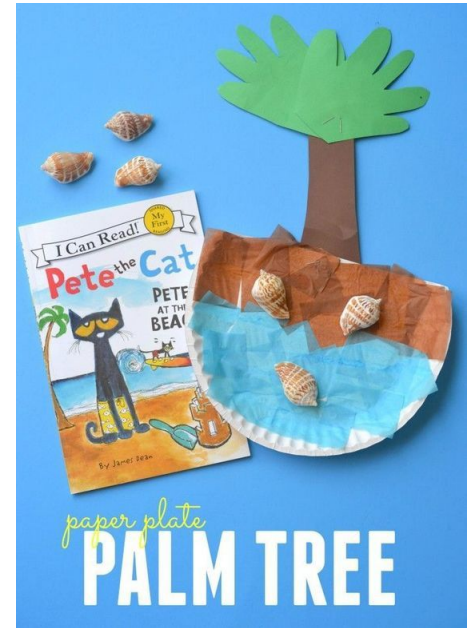
-Palm Tree Craft

Materials:

-Paper plate, -Brown, blue and green tissue paper or construction paper, Glue, Scissors, Stapler or tape, Markers/pencils

Directions:

- * First cut 1/4 of your paper plate off. This is where the palm tree will sit.
- * Next cut your brown & blue tissue paper into small squares.
- * Put glue all over the paper plate piece. Have children place a layer of brown tissue/construction paper for the sand and blue underneath that, for the water.
- * Then, trace your child's hands on the green paper for the palm tree leaves. Then cut out the trunk of the palm tree out of the brown paper.
- * To finish off the **Paper Plate Palm Tree** kid craft – staple/glue the cardstock pieces in their designated spots on the paper plate.
