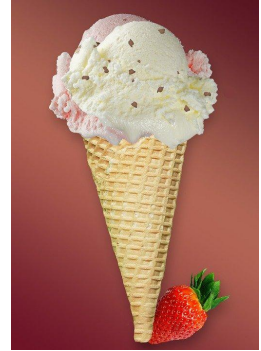

Talk about whether there is enough of things and then check. This will lead into ideas of “too many” or “too few”.
