Sound System Lesson: May 2020

Learning Target:

Students will review production of the /b/ phoneme in isolation, in the initial position of words, in the final position of words, and in the medial position of words.

Students will then practice the target words in sentences.

- Students will review and practice producing /b/ in words, using pictures in this worksheet.
- Students will practice simple sentences, building on the previous lessons.
