Early Childhood Special Education Math Lesson: May 18, 2020

Learning Target:

Students will be able to show understanding of ordinal placement.

Let's Get Started: <u>Learn Ordinal Numbers for Preschool</u>
<u>Ordinal Numbers song</u>

Practice:

Which car is winning the race, the red or yellow one?

The red one is winning, it is first.

The yellow one is second.



Practice: Which boat is winning the race?



The yellow boat is first.

The red boat is second.

Practice:

The children are running a race.

Point to the child who is first. Who is second? Which one is third? Which child is forth?



Activity:

Game: Which pot is it?

Put 4 or 5 empty yogurt pots upside down in a row. Then, while your child closes his eyes, hide a coin under one of them. See if he can find it from your description. When it is his turn to hide the coin, he may not be able to describe its position so you may need to ask questions to him, for example: "Is it under the first pot?"

*For older children use "left" and "right", for example: the third pot on the right.
