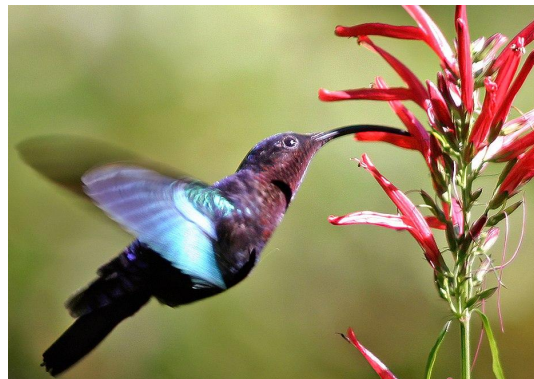
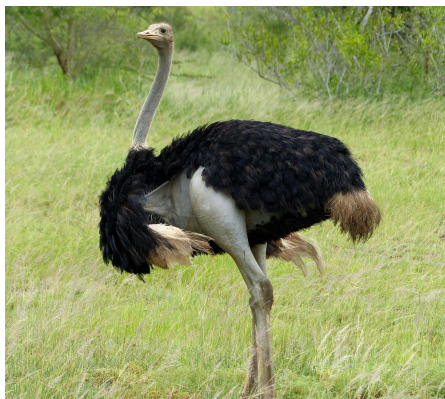


These eggs are the largest animal eggs in the world.
