Learning Target:

Students will learn how to be patient.

First, watch this video.

Remember:

To be patient means to wait in a calm way.



Can you think about when you need to wait?

When I want to go outside NOW, but mom says "later".



When I am at the grocery store, and I have to wait in line.





When my sister is playing with a toy that I want, and she says "no" when I ask for it.



When I ask my dad to play with me, but he is busy.



What can I do when I need to wait?

I can take a deep breath and say "It's ok. I can wait".



I can set a timer and wait for all the sand to go down.





I can find something else to do or play.




I can play simple games, like I Spy, with a grown-up while I wait.
