Early Ed Science Lesson: 4/6/2020

Learning Target: Students will explore safe handwashing.

Let's Get Started:

Watch Video: Baby Shark Wash Your Hands

Practice:

Point to each picture and talk with your child about each step.



Turn the water on.




Get your hands wet.



Put soap onto hands and rub hands together.



Rinse your hands.



Turn the water off.



Activity:

Science Experiment (Germs)

Materials needed: Bowl, Water, Pepper, Soap

- 1. Fill a bowl with some water. Sprinkle pepper into the water.
- 2. Tell your child that you are going to pretend the pepper are germs. Talk about what germs are.
- 3. Have your child touch the water with his/her finger. What happens?
- 4. Now put a little soap onto your child's finger.
- 5. Have your child touch the water with the soap on his/her finger. What happens?
- 6. Discuss with your child how washing his/her hands helps keep germs away. This keeps us healthy.
