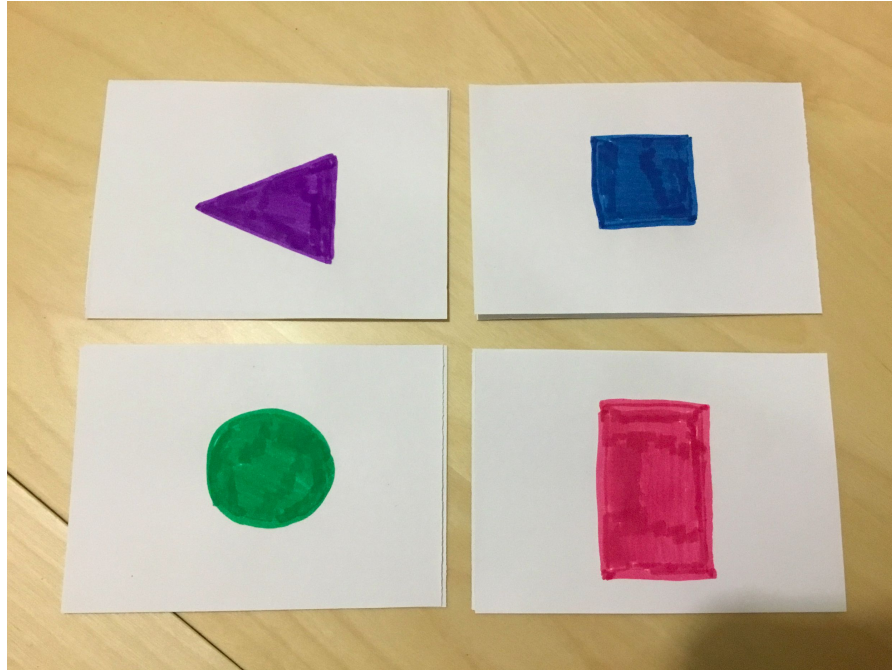
Learning Target:

This is a square.

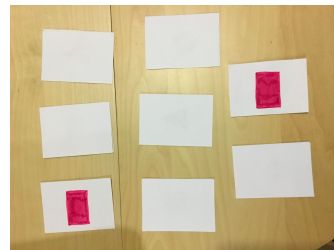
This is a circle.

Activity:

Shape Memory Game

Materials needed: Paper, Markers, Scissors



1. Cut paper into squares (Construction paper works best)
2. Draw a different shape on each square, but have at least two cards of each shape, so you can have a set.
3. Lay the shape cards face down.
4. Model for your child how to flip two cards over one at a time and identify if they are the same/different.
5. Continue until each shape is matched.

Another way to play is by adding other shapes, such as stars and hearts. To make it more challenging use letters or numbers.
