### **Learning Target:**

Students will explore with ice cubes.

Practice:  
Give your child items to dump, pour and explore in the water.



# Activity:

## Color Mixing Sensory Table

**Materials needed:** food coloring, water, ice cube tray, tub, and/ or large container or sensory table

1. Freeze a tray of ice cubes with a drop of food coloring in each section.
2. Dump the ice cubes into a container and watch the colors melt.
3. Ask you child:
  - a. What do you see?
  - b. What happens when the colors mix?
  - c. What colors do you see?
4. Use hands or kitchen utensils to stir, swirl, and mix.

Another way to play is put colored ice cubes in plastic bags and mix the colors as you watch them melt.
