Activity:

Sun Prints

Materials needed: dark colored paper, nature objects (leaves, sticks, rocks, flowers), plastic wrap

1. Explore your yard, and search for objects to use for your sun prints.
2. In a shady area, help your child arrange the outdoor objects on paper.
3. Cover the items with clear plastic wrap (or plexiglass) and weigh the edges down with rocks, so that the plastic lays flat and won't blow away.
4. Leave in the sun for 2-3 hours.
