Early Ed Literacy Lesson: 05/01/2020

Learning Target:


Students will explore paint, mixing colors, and making shapes.

Let's Get Started:

Watch Video: Mix the Colors Song

Practice:

Point to each color and say:
"Red and blue make purple."
"Yellow and blue make green."
"Red and yellow make orange."



Activity:

Rainbow in a bag

Materials needed: Shaving cream, food coloring, ziplock bag, tape

- 1. Mix shaving cream with food coloring to make different colors.
- 2. Scoop different colors of shaving cream into a ziplock bag and secure with tape.
- 3. Let your child squish around to make cool patterns or use your finger to draw shapes or letters.
- 4. Ask your child:
 - a. Tell me about your painting.
 - b. What colors do you see?
 - c. How does it feel?

Another way to play is have your child experiment with mixing two colors in a bag and see what color it makes!
