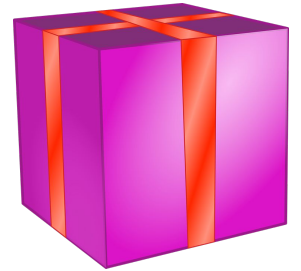
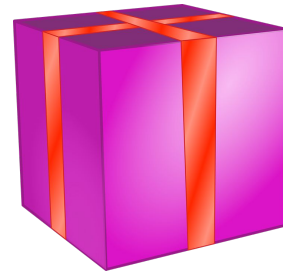
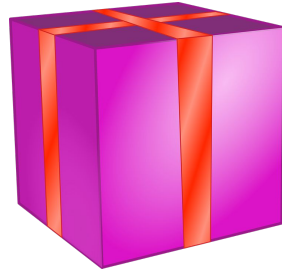
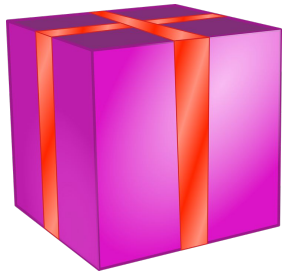
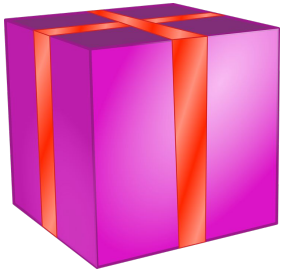
Students will guess the number of items in the guessing jar.

Activity:

Guessing Jar

Materials needed: Clear jar, small items to place in the jar (ex: cotton balls, small legos, small toys, small rocks),

1. Place 1-10 items in the jar.
2. Ask your child:
 - a. How many items do you think are in the jar?
3. Write their guess down.
4. Dump the items out and have your child count them.
5. Compare their guess to the count.
6. Continue playing with different number of items in the jar.
