Learning Target:

Practice:



Look closely at Pete's shoes. What do you see?

Do you see the soles, or the bottom of Pete's shoes?

Grommets are the little rings the laces go through. How many grommets do you see?

What color are they? What size are they?

Activity:

Shoe observational drawings

Materials needed: paper, drawing materials

1. Have your child select the shoe they wish to draw.
2. Allow your child to really examine the shoe. What details do they see?
3. You and your child can draw the same shoe or different shoes.
