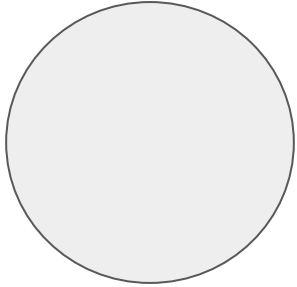
Learning Target:

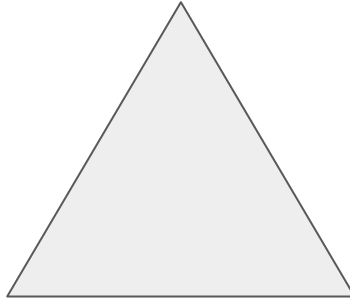

Activity:

Shape Memory Game

Materials needed: items of various shapes from around your home (ball, cookie cutter, cell phone, etc)

Cloth to cover items (towel, blanket, etc)

1. Select items of various shapes and present to your child.
2. Ask child to look at and name the shapes.
3. Cover the shapes and take one item away.
4. Uncover and ask your child to name which shape is missing? Identify shapes that are present?
