Pre-K Literacy Lesson: 04/8/2020

Learning Target:

Students will demonstrate knowledge of main characters and events.

Let's Get Started:

Watch Video: <u>Animation of The Very Hungry Caterpillar by</u>

Eric Carle

Practice: What happens after the caterpillar eats all the food?



The Hungry Caterpillar gets a stomach ache.

Activity:

Retell the story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar

Materials needed: The Very Hungry Caterpillar

- 1. Rewatch the story.
- 2. Ask your child these questions:
 - a. Who is the character in the story? (The caterpillar)
 - b. If they don't remember what a character is ask, "Who is the story about?" (The caterpillar)
 - c. Tell me one food the caterpillar ate that caused the stomach ache (Pie, cake, candy, sausage)

If your student is able to retell the story you can ask them these follow up questions:

- 1. How many days in a row did the caterpillar eat? (Mon. Tues. Wed. Thurs. Fri. Sat. Sun.)
- 2. How many strawberries did the caterpillar eat? (4 Strawberries on Thursday)
- 3. What did the caterpillar make as a home? (Cocoon)
