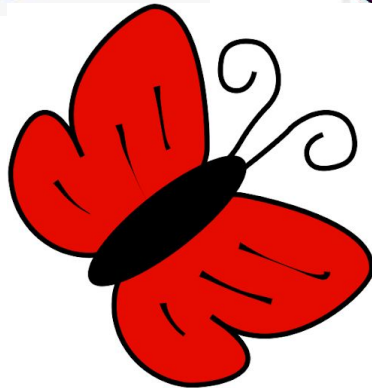
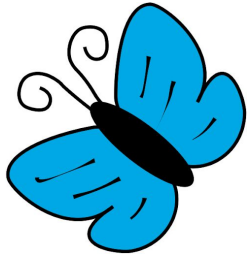
Learning Target:

Students will create and experiment with colors.

Practice:
Point to each butterfly and name its color



Activity:

Paper Plate Rainbow

Materials needed: paper plate (cut in half), crayons/markers, glue, cotton balls

1. Parents cut a paper plate in half
2. Students color the paper plate in arches, using colors of the rainbow
3. Glue cotton balls to the bottom corners of the paper plate to represent clouds



Another way to create if you don't have glue or paper plates: You can use a piece of paper and cut out a half circle. If you don't have glue you don't have to add clouds. The rainbow will look great however you decide to make it!
