


### Pre-K Art Lesson: 04/9/2020

### Learning Target: Students will create and experiment with colors.

#### Let's Get Started: Watch Video: <u>The Rainbow Colors Song</u>

## Practice: Point to each butterfly and name its color



# Activity:

#### Paper Plate Rainbow

Materials needed: paper plate (cut in half), crayons/markers, glue, cotton balls

- 1. Parents cut a paper plate in half
- 2. Students color the paper plate in arches, using colors of the rainbow
- 3. Glue cotton balls to the bottom corners of the paper plate to represent clouds



Another way to create if you don't have glue or paper plates: You can use a piece of paper and cut out a half circle. If you don't have glue you don't have to add clouds. The rainbow will look great however you decide to make it!
