#### Pre-K Science Lesson: 04/13/2020


#### Learning Target: Students will make and document observations.


#### Let's Get Started: Watch Video: <u>Can You Plant a Bean?</u>

## Practice: What do you observe in each picture?









### Activity:

#### Seed Germinating

Materials needed: paper towel, dry beans, water, plastic baggie

- 1. Fold the paper towel in half (or smaller if needed).
- 2. Dip the paper towel into water to get damp and squeeze out excess water.
- 3. Open up the paper towel and place 3-5 beans on the paper towel.
- 4. Fold the paper towel to cover the beans and place paper towel in plastic baggie.
- 5. Hang the ziploc bag up on a window and watch what happens over the week.

#### Watch Video: <u>How to Grow Seeds in a Plastic Bag</u>

An extension for this activity is to have the student document what they observe happening with the beans in a journal. They could draw a picture of what they see or for older students, they could describe what they see and an adult could write it down.
