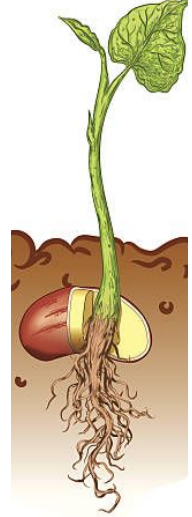
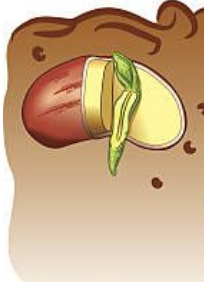
Learning Target:

Students will make and document observations.

Activity:

Seed Germinating

Materials needed: paper towel, dry beans, water, plastic baggie

1. Fold the paper towel in half (or smaller if needed).
2. Dip the paper towel into water to get damp and squeeze out excess water.
3. Open up the paper towel and place 3-5 beans on the paper towel.
4. Fold the paper towel to cover the beans and place paper towel in plastic baggie.
5. Hang the ziploc bag up on a window and watch what happens over the week.

An extension for this activity is to have the student document what they observe happening with the beans in a journal. They could draw a picture of what they see or for older students, they could describe what they see and an adult could write it down.
