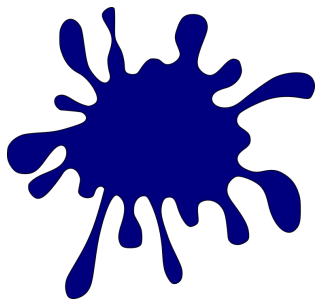
Students will experiment with tools for painting.

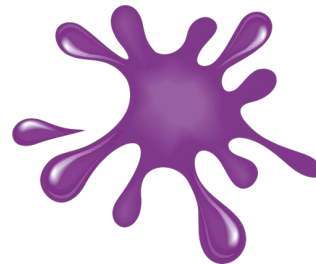

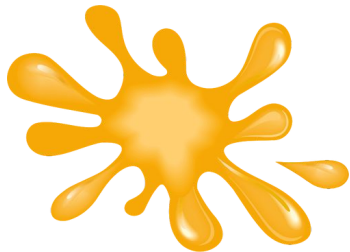

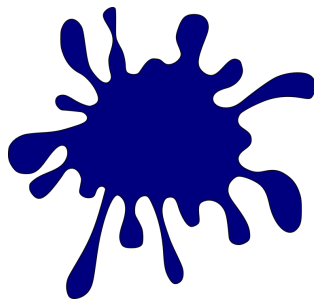

# Activity:

## Painting

**Materials needed:** watercolor, paper, brush (q-tip, toothbrush, etc.)

1. Have your child write their name.
2. Dip paintbrush in water and then in paint and begin.
3. As your child paints say, “Tell me about it...”
4. Further questions.
  - What happens when you mix colors?
  - How did you do that?
  - What new colors did you make?
  - What does it remind you of?
  - Tell me what happened?
