Clap to the syllables.

Activity:

Clap With Me Scavenger Hunt!

Materials needed: Objects you find around the house.

- 1. Explain that your child's name has syllables.
- 2. Show an example clapping your hands as you say the syllables in their name.
- 3. Have your child clap to their name.
- 4. Find various objects around the house.
- 5. Clap the syllables of the object they find.
