How many syllables do these words have? Clap it out.

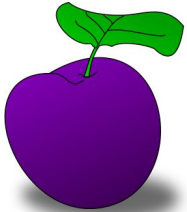
Plum

1 Syllable



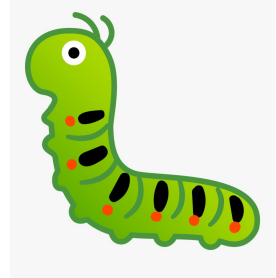
2 Syllables

Activity:

Clap out the number of syllables.

Materials needed: Any objects around the house.

1. Search around the house or yard for objects.
2. Say the word of the object and count out the number of syllables in each word.
 - a. 1 Syllable - Car, dog, book
 - b. 2 Syllables- Tablet, pillow, window
 - c. 3 Syllables - Microwave, computer
 - d. 4 Syllables - Television, Independence
