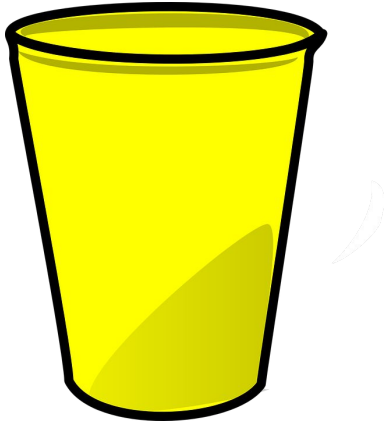

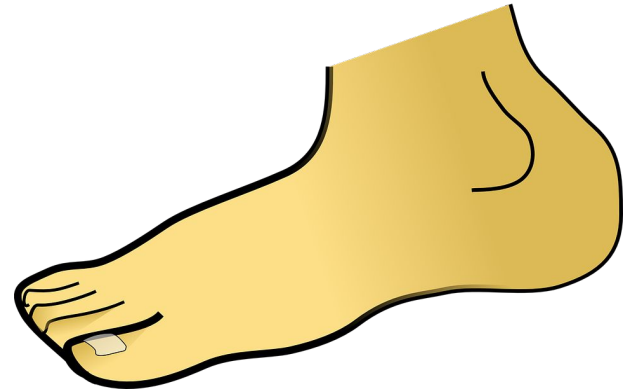
Stacks blocks as

Activity:

Stacking Blocks

Materials needed: Blocks

1. Start stacking your blocks one on top of each other
2. Count the blocks as you stack
3. Build as tall as you can
4. Repeat steps 1-3 on different surfaces (carpet, hardwood, table, paper, etc...)
5. Ask your child:
 - a. Which surface was the easiest to stack? Why?
 - b. What surface do you think would be hard to stack blocks on? Why?
