Learning Target:


Students will sort objects in two or more groups.

Let's Get Started:

Watch Video: <u>Sesame Street: Sorting with Cookie Monster</u> <u>and Ernie</u>

Practice:

How can these pictures be sorted?



Activity:

Sorting

Materials needed: Crayons, pencils, and pens (cups are optional)

- 1. Place the items in front of your child. Ask them to look at the items and think how they could put similar items together.
- 2. Ask your child to sort the items into three different groups.
- 3. After child has sorted materials, ask them:
 - a. How are items in this group similar?
 - b. How did your sort the items?
 - c. What is different about these groups?



Extension:

Another way to do this activity is by providing your child with other materials such as: coins, buttons, skittles, m & m candies, or cereal.

Ask your child:

- How many objects are in each group?
- What group has the most objects?
- What group has the least objects?
