Learning Target:

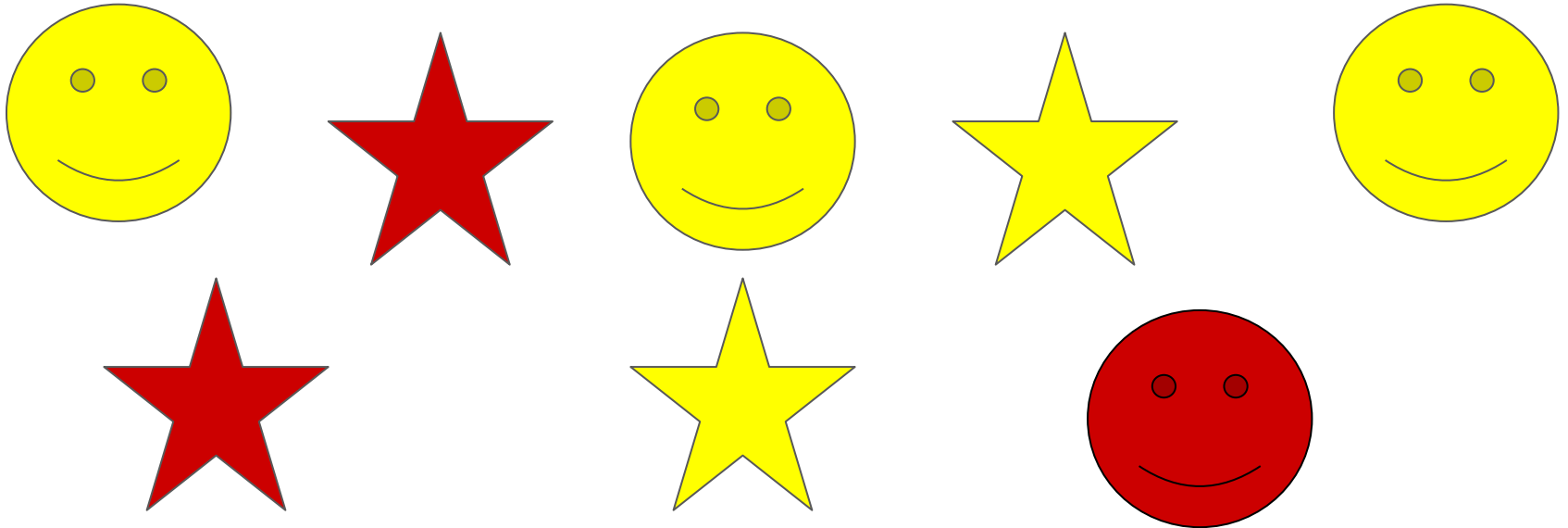
Students will sort objects in two or more groups.

Practice:

How can these pictures be sorted?



Activity:

Sorting

Materials needed: Crayons, pencils, and pens (cups are optional)

1. Place the items in front of your child. Ask them to look at the items and think how they could put similar items together.
2. Ask your child to sort the items into three different groups.
3. After child has sorted materials, ask them:
 - a. How are items in this group similar?
 - b. How did you sort the items?
 - c. What is different about these groups?



Extension:

Another way to do this activity is by providing your child with other materials such as: coins, buttons, skittles, m & m candies, or cereal.

Ask your child:

- How many objects are in each group?
- What group has the most objects?
- What group has the least objects?
