Learning Target:

Students will create a three-dimensional representation.

Let's Get Started:

Watch Videos: Bear Hunt with Binoculars

Practice:

What are these items? What could we make out of these items that we have at home?



necklace, bracelet, glue to paper for art...



build towers, create a pencil holder, make tunnels...

Activity:

Homemade Binoculars

Materials needed: 2 toilet paper rolls, or 1 paper towel roll cut in half, paint, crayons or markers,, glue/tape/stapler. (optional: string/yarn/twine and hole punch)

- 1. Using paint, crayons, or markers, have your child decorate their toilet paper/paper towel rolls.
- Once they are done if you used a paper towel roll cut it in half.
- 3. Staple or glue both of the pieces together to create the eye lookouts for the binoculars.
- 4. After it is dried, add two holes to the two pieces to string yarn, twine, or string through for the neck strap.
- 5. While doing all of these steps you can talk to your child about all of the ways they can use binoculars and what they might see whenever they use them outside of the house.

After you complete the craft, take a nature walk with your new binoculars and have your child use them to find animals/things outside.
