Learning Target:

Students will sort objects into two or more groups and then re-sort.

Let's Get Started:

Practice:

How are these toys the same? How are these toys different?



Activity:

Secret Sorting Rule

Materials needed: Several items that are different (cars, blocks, silverware, coins, pencils, etc.)

- 1. Sort the items you collected into 3 groups. (Size, color, shape, weight, use, etc...)
- 2. Ask your child:
 - a. How did I sort these items?
 - b. How are the items in these pile the same?
 - c. How are the piles different?
- 3. Using the same items, re-sort based on a different characteristic.
- 4. Repeat step 2.
- 5. Have your child re-sort the same items using different characteristics.
- 6. Ask your child:
 - a. How are the items in this pile the same?
 - b. How did you sort all these items?
